18 to 20	A	<i>The student shows that he/she deeply masters the subject, beyond the information he has been given. He/she is able to solve problems on his own when necessary. He/she has a critical mind and a capacity to synthesize out of the ordinary (Excellent)</i>
15/16/17	B	<i>The student was above the average standard. No problem or default. The initiatives he/she took were justified. He could analyse the situation on his own as well as synthesize. (Very Good)</i>
13/14	C	<i>The student was interested in the subject. No default could be noticed. Good reaction of the student when a trend is suggested to him/her or when he/she must think of it. He/she sometimes takes good initiatives. (Good)</i>
11/12	D	<i>The student has proved of goodwill or of a certain ability. Very slight problem. and defaults. The critical mind and the ability to synthesize are unfortunately lacking. (Acceptable)</i>
10	E	<i>The student could certainly have done better than that. The problems. and defaults are quite important but acceptable and do not prevent the professional integration. (Weak)</i>
9 or less	F	<i>The student has shown a real lack of goodwill and inability. The defaults and problems are very serious even intolerable. A satisfactory professional integration cannot be considered. (Failed)</i>
